Malaria is a preventable and treatable dis-
ease that kills more than one million peo-
ple a year. Lutheran Malaria Initiative
and Lutheran World Relief have part-
nered up in the global effort to eliminate
malaria deaths in Africa by 2015.

For every \$10 raised a family was pro-
vided with a treated bed net. Grace was
able to raise \$1163.07 through our Sum-
mer Sunday School and VBS this year.
That is almost 120 bed nets. Wow, that
was awesome!!! Thanks be to God for
the willing and generous hearts of our
congregation.
