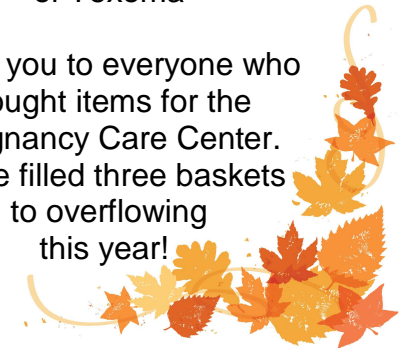
If you have a mug hanging on the kitchen wall please take home. We will be removing the rack in two weeks. Thank you.
